Dear Colleagues,

As we wait to warmly welcome to the Rizzoli Orthopaedic Institute those European friends and colleagues who will join us here in Bologna in April 2010, we would like to say a few words explaining the philosophy of this experts' meeting.

We have noted how it has recently become difficult to discuss the common interests of sports traumatologists and team doctors and physicians, who are involved day by day in preserving the health and sporting performance of their athletes.

There is a trend toward highly-specialised surgeons holding closed discussions between themselves, without considering the true interests of the athletes in their own health and their own performance. Our meeting offers a unique occasion to underline and discuss problems that, on the one hand, require difficult solutions, but on the other must be clearly understood by us all.

Moreover, we would like to get past the old concept of "watertight compartment" treatment for high-level athletes, in order to build a more holistic approach in which everybody and – most of all – team doctors share their practical experience. In this way, Europe will continue its tradition as the source of new ideas and therapeutic solutions.
